

## **Draft Resolutions from the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of ISO/TMB/WG SR, Quebec, Canada, 2009-05-18—22**

### **Resolution 1**

ISO/TMB/WG SR approves the reports of TG 1, TG 2 and TG 3 as presented by the convenors in plenary.

### **Resolution 2**

ISO/TMB/WG SR expresses its great appreciation to the following donors to ISO/DEVCO for their contributions to enhance stakeholder participation and for having extended their support projects for a further period of 2 years until 2010:

- The Finnish Government; and
- The Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA)

### **Resolution 3**

ISO/TMB/WG SR expresses its great appreciation to Sony Corporation for its donation to the ISO SR Trust Fund to enhance stakeholder participation.

### **Resolution 4**

ISO/TMB/WG SR, recognizing the need for on-going communication on ISO 26000 to reach a wider range of stakeholders and potential users, recommends reconvening interested WG SR participants at regular intervals after the standard is published. ISO/TMB/WG SR requests especially TG 1 and TG 2 to explore funding support to undertake such communication and meetings.

### **Resolution 5**

ISO/TMB/WG SR urges all ISO members to start implementing the *Guide for development of ISO 26000 communication plan* (Document ISO/TMB/WG SR N159) without further delay.

### **Resolution 6**

ISO/TMB/WG SR encourages participating National Standard Bodies and Language Task Forces to translate the *Guide for development of ISO 26000 communication plan* (Document ISO/TMB/WG SR N159) into their respective languages, and provide the translations to TG 2 to be posted on the public WG SR website.

ISO/TMB/WG SR notes that document ISO/TMB/WG SR N160 shows that some National Standard Bodies do not have the participation of all stakeholder groups in their mirror committees and calls upon all participating National Standard Bodies to take active measures to obtain participation of and promote balance across of all stakeholder groups.

**Resolution 9**

ISO/TMB/WG SR approves the agreed ways forward from the Clause Specific Meetings as reported or discussed in plenary and presented in document ISO/TMB/WG SR N 168, as the basis for drafting the DIS of ISO 26000.

**Resolution 11**

ISO/TMB/WG SR requests the Integrated Drafting Task Force (IDTF) to produce a detailed Drafting Plan for the drafting of ISO 26000 from now up to the next meeting of ISO/TMB/WG SR. The plan is to be circulated within 3 weeks by the ISO/TMB/WG SR Secretariat to the ISO/TMB/WG SR.

**Resolution 12**

ISO/TMB/WG SR requests ISO Council to make ISO 26000 and all previous drafts available free of charge and asks the ISO/TMB/WG SR Secretariat, in consultation with the CAG, to provide the ISO Council with the reasons for doing so.

**Resolution 13**

ISO/TMB/WG SR expresses its gratitude to Danish Standards and the Danish Ministry of Business and Economic Affairs for offering to host the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of ISO/TMB/WG SR in Copenhagen, Denmark. Dates will be announced in due course by the ISO/TMB/WG SR Secretariat.
